

Emergency Conflagration Act

Oregon Revised Statutes 476.510 – 476.610

The Emergency Conflagration Act authorizes the Governor to assign and make available for use and duty in any county, city or district, any part of the fire fighting forces and equipment of any fire fighting organization in this state in order to protect life and property against the dangers of fire.

If the Governor is not available, the Superintendent of State Police may exercise this authority. If the Superintendent of State Police is not available, the State Fire Marshal may exercise this authority.

The state shall reimburse the political subdivision supplying fire fighting resources summoned under an Emergency Conflagration declared by the Governor, or the Governor's designee.
