

Oregon-Washington Interstate Fire Protection Operation Plan

The Interstate Fire Protection Operation Plan ensures the efficient securing to each periodic emergency, fire fighting assistance for the protection of life and property. The Plan is established in order to provide a mechanism and resources when the host state's resources have been exhausted.

The Plan is entered into by the Governors of Oregon and Washington pursuant to the provisions of the Interstate Civil Defense and Disaster Compact (1951) and Section 552 Title 16 of the United States Code and Supplemental Agreement and Plan No. 77-1 executed by Oregon and Washington in 1977.

The party providing mutual aid assistance shall be reimbursed in cash according to each state's Mobilization Personnel and Equipment Rate Reimbursement Schedules.
