

The Oregon Mobilization Plan

The *Mobilization Plan* establishes operating procedures for the most practical utilization of state fire fighting resources for emergencies, which are beyond the capabilities of the local fire service resources. It assumes that mutual aid has been rendered from reciprocal, non-reimbursed fire fighting resources in or near the area experiencing the emergency.

Under the Emergency Conflagration Act, fire fighting resources from any fire organization in the state are used when the State Fire Marshal believes that a fire is causing, or may cause, undue jeopardy to life and/or property, and the Act is invoked by the Governor.

The *Mobilization Plan* may be used separately from the Conflagration Act to mobilize local structural fire agencies for any emergency situation exceeding local mutual aid resources. However, reimbursement for responding resources is assured only when the Governor invokes the Conflagration Act.
